

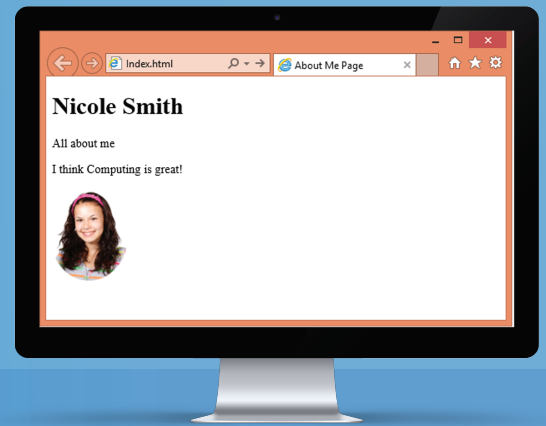

Declaration

Name	Declaration	Function
!DOCTYPE	<!DOCTYPE>	This declaration is the very first thing in a HTML document, before the <html> tag. It tells the web browser which version of HTML the page is written in.

Tags

HTML tags define a web page's structure. These are generally used in pairs that include an opening and a closing tag. When a web page is rendered in a browser, the tags are not visible to the user.

Name	Tag (opening and closing)	Function
HTML	<html></html>	Hyper Text Markup Language
Head	<head></head>	The head, or prologue, of the HTML document
Body	<body></body>	All the other content that is contained in the HTML document
Title	<title></title>	The title of the document
Paragraph	<paragraph></paragraph>	Used to indicate a paragraph. Browsers automatically add a margin before and after each <p> element
Heading 1	<h1></h1>	Defines the most important heading, h1
Heading 6	<h6></h6>	Defines the least important heading, h6
Break	 	This tag inserts a single line break. The tag is an empty tag, which means there is no end tag
Image		This tag defines an image in an HTML page. Both src and alt are required
Link	Click for Google	This defines a hyperlink, that is to link from one page to another. By default this displays in blue
Bold		This renders text as bold
